Youth-led, community-friendly delivery of next-generation prevention choices, with equitable access for adolescent girls, young women and young persons with disabilities.

SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTIONS (STIs): REVERSING THE SILENT SURGE

Rapid point-of-care diagnostics and peer-led express testing networks that move beyond stigma and syndromic management.

TEENAGE AND UNPLANNED PREGNANCY: BODILY AUTONOMY & LEGAL ALIGNMENT

Legal harmonisation, removal of third-party consent barriers and adolescent-centred contraceptive self-care pathways.
